

REGULAR MEETING OF LAUREL RUN BOROUGH COUNCIL – JUNE 16, 2026 - 7:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Shandra with The Pledge to The Flag, followed by a moment of silence. Roll was taken.

MINUTES: A motion to accept the minutes from the April regular meeting was made by John Mosley, Jr., seconded by Jason Hardy.

TREASURER’S REPORT: A motion to accept the Treasurer’s Report for the months of May and June was made by John Mosley, Jr., seconded by Jason Hardy.

TAX COLLECTOR’S REPORT: A motion to accept the Tax Collector’s reports for the months of May and June and authorize she be paid commission on the same was made by Jason Hardy, seconded by John Mosley, Jr.

RECEIPTS: A motion to accept the receipts from April 22, 2026 to June 16, 2026 and authorize their deposit in the appropriate accounts was made by John Mosley, Jr., seconded by Jason Hardy.

EXPENSES: A motion to approve the payment of the expenses from April 22, 2026 to June 16, 2026 was made by John Mosley, Jr., seconded by Jason Hardy

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT: Jolene read the written report for the month of May.

A motion was made by Jason Hardy to accept the report, seconded by John Mosley, Jr.

ROADS AND STREETS: Joe said the repairs to Mt. Oaks Drive were not done yet. He will re-assess them.

Council further discussed the possible preparation of an agreement transferring maintenance responsibility to D&L for the device at the pedestrian crosswalk. Shandra said she has the monthly meeting with Penn Dot regarding the crosswalk tomorrow.

BUILDING AND GROUNDS REPORT: Regarding the dumping on Dickerson Street, the property is owned by several people. Joe Tavaglione said he will try to get what he can with the backhoe next time he is there.

PLANNING AND ZONING: Amos Valenti report that two permits were issued. The Secretary said she did not received payment for either as of yet.

There is one vacancy each on both the Planning Commission and the Zoning Hearing Board. Council agreed that The Mayor should appeal to residents on Laurel Run Rant and Rave to seek they filled.

ENGINEER'S REPORT: The written report was reviewed.

A motion to approve the proposal by Barry Isett for the Borough to sign their Engineering proposal for the 2024 ARLE Grant – SR2007 Pedestrian Crossing was made by John Mosley, Jr., seconded by Jason Hardy.

A motion for the Borough to sign Barry Isett's Engineering proposal for the Pole Bard Phase I Reallocation for Heating/AC and minor building renovations was made by John Mosley, Jr., seconded by Jason Hardy.

The Borough agreed that the balance of the \$9,625.00 from the 2024 LSA Grant – Pole Bare Phase II will be allocated to the purchase of solar lighting to be installed by the Borough at a later date.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT: Atty. Menn reported that he spoke with Atty. Burke, who represents Mr. Corgan regarding an easement, or possible donation of the land needed for the Rails to Trails project. He is waiting to hear on it.

Steve said he will get a copy of Plains Township Data Center Ordinance for the Boroughs review for July.

Steve said there should be a 4 to 7% range of total land within the Borough allocated to the construction of Data Centers and there should be multiple owners of the land – not just one.
