

REGULAR MEETING OF LAUREL RUN BOROUGH COUNCIL – MARCH 17, 2026 - 7:00 P.M.

ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order by Shandra with The Pledge to The Flag, followed by a moment of silence. Roll was taken.

Randal Shovlin of 1981 Pine Run Road said he would like to construct a garage that would be larger than permitted by the Borough building code. Council advised him to apply for a permit, get denied and then file for a variance.

MINUTES: A motion to accept the minutes from the January regular meeting was made by John Mosley, Jr., seconded by Jason Hardy.

TREASURER'S REPORT: A motion to accept the Treasurer's Report for the month of February was made by John Mosley, Jr., seconded by Jason Hardy.

RECEIPTS: A motion to accept the receipts from February 18, 2026 to March 17, 2026 and authorize their deposit in the appropriate accounts was made by John Mosley, Jr., seconded by Jason Hardy.

EXPENSES: A motion to approve the payment of the expenses from February 18, 2026 to March 17, 2026 was made by Jason Hardy, seconded by John Mosley, Jr.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT: Jolene read the written report for the month of March.

A motion was made by Jason Hardy to accept the report, seconded by John Mosler, Jr.

ROADS AND STREETS: No update on the Mt. Oaks Drive shoulder repairs. Shandra told the DPW crew that she would like the repairs done as soon as possible.

Shandra said Ridge Road storm drains are blocked by leaves and that the runoff is freezing – she said it probably is happening on the other Borough roads – she asked the DPW crew to clear them of the leaves.

A motion to accept the report was made by John Mosley, Jr., seconded by Jason Hardy.

PLANNING AND ZONING: The Secretary said the State meeting to approve or disapprove the reallocation of the Pole Barn money grant to the HVAC Borough Building system was slated for 3/18. She said she would advise all if approved – and as for an extension.

A motion to accept the report was made by Jason Hardy, seconded by John Mosley, Jr.

ENGINEER'S REPORT: The written report was reviewed.

There was a discussion regarding the property needed for the construction of the walkway for the Rails to Trails, ARLE grant at the base of Giant's Despair. Atty. Menn said the Borough could obtain a quick claim deed for the property that it appears Mike Corgan owns, per the survey done by the D&L Trail entity.

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A motion to accept the report was made by John Mosley, Jr., seconded by Jason Hardy.

MAYOR'S REPORT: The Mayor said due to no heat in the Borough Building, there would be no Easter Egg Hunt this year.

OLD BUSINESS: Shandra said she met with Rock Stahovic and he educated her on Data Centers. She would like the Borough to have an ordinance regulating data center construction within the Borough. Atty. Menn said the most likely areas would be those in "C" district (Conservation). He advised to have an overlay within these areas as to where the centers could be located.

Three Springs is seeking an increase in their water draw at there facility. John Mosley said he recalls back in the early 2000's they desired to increase their water draw and the Chesapeake Bay Watershed intervened.

A motion to adjourn was made by Jason Hardy, seconded by John Mosley, Jr.
