

REGULAR MEETING OF LAUREL RUN BOROUGH COUNCIL – FEBRUARY 18, 2025 - 7:10 P.M.

ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order by Shandra with The Pledge to The Flag, followed by a moment of silence. Roll was taken.

MINUTES: A motion to accept the minutes from the January regular meeting was made by John Mosley, seconded by Shandra Kisailus.

TREASURER'S REPORT: A motion to accept the Treasurer's Report for the months of February was made by John Mosley, seconded by Shandra Kisailus.

TAX COLLECTOR'S REPORT: A motion to accept the Tax Collectors Report for the month of January was made by John Mosley, seconded by Shandra Kisailus. Motion carried.

RECEIPTS: A motion to accept the receipts from January 22, 2025 to February 18, 2025 and authorize their deposit in the appropriate accounts was made by John Mosley, seconded by Shandra Kisailus.

EXPENSES: A motion to approve the payment of the expenses from January 22, 2025 to February 18, 2025 was made by John Mosley, seconded by Shandra Kisailus.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT: Jolene read the written report. A motion to accept the report from February was made by John Mosley, seconded by Shandra Kisailus.

ROADS AND STREETS: No update on the Drain Tec cleaning Parrish Road drain.

Someone reinstalled the street sign for Ridge Road. There is no update on the stop sign at the end of Parrish Road.

No update on the remaining documents needed for the Pole Barn Grant monies.

The Borough depleted their allotment of salt from Cargill and is in need of more salt. Jolene will try to procure from another vendor.

A motion to accept the report was made by John Mosley, seconded by Shandra Kisailus.

BUILDING AND GROUNDS: No update on the septic tank cleaning.

A motion to accept the report was made by Shandra Kisailus, seconded by John Mosley.

ENGINEER'S REPORT: Rock reviewed his written report. The Secretary gave him the signed contracts for the feasibility study. He said in order to assess the Vitale property **purchase**, access to the property would be needed with permission from the owners. Shandra said the Borough is in no position financially to purchase it, so it would be better to research properties the Borough already own.

A motion to accept it was made by John Mosley, seconded by Shandra Kisailus.

MAYOR'S REPORT: The Mayor said tweaks are needed to the website, but it is up and running. There is a \$350.00 per quarter maintenance fee.

CORRESPONDENCE: Council approved Christine and Jason Hardy to serve as Crime Watch Directors.

NEW BUSINESS: Barry Isett has a zoning officer, Phillip Krout, whom the Borough can appoint, with the stipulation he also serve as Building Codes Compliance Officer. Atty. Menn suggested fee schedules be attained by Isett and BHW for comparison, before any changes are made.

Council chooses not to renew the cyber insurance policy. The Mayor said the property at 3780 Laurel Run Road is a concern. There is much garbage piled in the back.
